



Photography in Iceland and Greenland with Eliot Cohen

Depart the U.S. on Saturday, July 15, and arrive back in the U.S. on Friday, July 28, 2016

Sat,	7/15	Afternoon flight to Keflavik. Late evening arrival. (Hotel Berg)
Sun,	7/16	Pick up SUV's and drive to Hella, photographing waterfalls and landscape all along the route. (Hotel Stracta).
Mon,	7/17	Full day in Landmannalaugar (Icelandic highlands). (Hotel Stracta)
Tue,	7/18	Photograph waterfalls and other features along the south coast as we drive to Kirkjubaejarklaustur. (Hotel Laki)
Wed,	7/19	Drive and photograph along the south coast. Glaciers and a beautiful coastal island with puffins and other birds. Evening at Jokulsarlon Glaciar Lagoon. (Brunnholl Guesthouse)
Thurs,	7/20	Jokulsarlon Glaciar Lagoon and other glaciers. (Fosshotel Vatnajokull near Hofn)
Fri,	7/21	Stokksnes (dramatic black sand beach) and other sites near Hofn. (Fosshotel, Vatnajokull near Hofn)
Sat,	7/22	Drive from Hofn to Vik (black sand beach, sea stacks, beautiful caves with basalt formations, fields of lupine). Photography along the way. (Hotel Edda, Vik)
Sun,	7/23	Waterfalls and other scenic locations, ending up in Reykjavik. (Hotel Holt)
Mon	7/24	AM flight to Ilulissat, Greenland. Evening charter for midnight sun. (Hotel Arctic)
Tue,	7/25	AM charter boat to photograph whales and icebergs from the water. Evening hike to overlook the glacier fjord. (Hotel Arctic)
Wed,	7/26	AM photography in the rocky tundra near the hotel and in Ilulissat. Evening charter for midnight sun. (Hotel Arctic)
Thurs,	7/27	AM flight to Reyjkavik. (Hotel Holt)
Fri, 7/28		AM or PM flight to U.S. Same day arrival.

I'll arrange our specific itinerary based on weather and light. Above is a pretty good representation of how our days will work, but we may vary our plans based on what the light offers. Much of our best light may be very late in the eveing through very early morning, so we'll adapt to the light as much as we can. We'll shoot during the daytime as well – waterfalls, glaciers, Icelandic horses, puffins, and much more.

The tour is designed for 7-11 people. The cost of the workshop is \$6,895 for shared accomodations and assumes 10-11 participants. The cost includes: all hotels and breakfasts, an excursion to a headlands where we can photograph puffins, one whale cruise and two midnight sun boat charters in Greenland. Standard accomodations in Iceland are typically quite simple and small. All of our accomodations have en-suite baths and are nicely positioned for the areas we want to photograph. In Greenland, we will have a very high level of hotel and accomodation.

Single accomodations are an option. The surcharge would be \$1290.

In the event we travel with 7-9 people there would be an additional charge of \$600.

Additional costs include our international flights (estimate \$800), our flight to Greenland (estimate \$1300), car rental (estimate \$900-1200 per person), travel insurance, meals other than breakfast, and anything of a personal nature, as well as any individual transportation other than that with the group.

To reserve a place in the workshop a deposit of \$3,450 is required, with the balance (\$3,445) due February 1, 2017. Please send an email to info@eliotcohen.com to confirm availability and then your check can be mailed to:

Please check with me prior to making international air arrangements to confirm that the workshop is running as planned and that your arrival/departure will coordinate with our group travel schedule.

A standard liability waiver will be forwarded to participants prior to departure. I do not expect extreme exertion in any of our activities, but we may be walking for several hours at a time. You should be in good health and capable of this level of activity.

Cancellations/refunds:

Oct. 31, 2016 or prior: Of the deposit, \$1,200 is non-refundable unless a replacement can take your place, in which case, a \$750 cancellation fee will be deducted.

Nov. 1, 2016 or later: The deposit will be refunded if a replacement can take your place less a cancellation fee of \$750.

Feb 1, 2017 or later, the workshop fee will be refunded only if another participant can take your place, in which case, a \$1200 cancellation fee will be deducted.

Once purchased, the airfare to Greenland is non refundable unless someone takes your place and I can transfer the ticket. In the past I have been able to do so.

I would strongly suggest trip insurance to cover anything unforseen.
